The Critical Incident Team members are trained for debriefing of fellow officers, family members, and others who may need the service. The team also assists the family during this difficult time with funeral arrangements and details. The Critical Incident Team is recognized throughout the country for their caring, sensitivity, and professional demeanor.
